The Hamilton Gounty South River District


We're here to explore ways the "Hamilton County South River District" from 116th Street to 146th Street can become a destination.


The idea is to determine how to create a district through collaboration, shared identity, complementary offerings, and storytelling.

- Conner Prairie "West Property"/Conner Prairie White River Education and Ecology Center (146th St. south toward 131st St.)
- River Road Park (approximately 126th St.)
- River Heritage Park (just north of 116th St.)
- White River Greenway (connecting areas between 146th St. & 116th St.)
- Thomas Marcuccilli Nature Park (146th St. and River Rd.)

- Identify opportunities for partnerships that support implementation of the Museum's Master Plan, including public partnerships to support a new river ecology education center








Conner Prairie Master Plan


- » River Ecology Center was a top implementation priority
- » River Ecology Center is envisioned as possible through multiple public/private partnerships
- » This center would allow visitors a chance to experience the White River and its role in the region's history and ecosystem.
- » Vision would establish a living laboratory and classroom within an integrated educational environment
- » Center is an integral part of the activation of the west side of the White River complimentary to future projects such as a food farm and energy experience, a farm to table restaurant, a river innovation center, public and private trails, and two bridges across the White River























Scale and Appendent of Buildings and Spaces













