A Few Notes on River Safety


- Be aware of your surroundings and river conditions, including the potential for flooding.
- (1) **Touch the river with your feet**, not your face and be aware of water quality concerns.
- **Be considerate** of fishermen and give them adequate space. When fishing, be sure to have a license and follow consumption guidelines.
- Navigate carefully, being aware of hazards, dams, paddlers, and boaters.
- Be a good steward by not littering, trespassing on private property, or disturbing wildlife or habitat.
- Wear a life jacket at all times when on the water.
